A longer term prospect, a 100% Mourvedre cuvee aged in barrel, the 2010 Cotes du Luberon Chateau Fontvert Mourre Negre exhibits a deep blue/purple color as well as notes of mulberries, blueberry liqueur, blackberries, licorice, incense, camphor and lead pencil shavings. Rich, full-bodied, moderately tannic and still primary and backward, it has the potential to evolve like a top-notch Bandol and age for 12-15+ years.

Made in a similar style, the 2010 Cotes du Luberon Chateau Fontvert is a blend of equal parts tank-aged Grenache and demi-muid-aged Syrah. This exuberant, dense purple-colored Provencal fruit bomb reveals beautiful notes of blueberries, boysenberries, black cherries and raspberries and enough spice, pepper and earth for additional complexity. This luscious wine should drink well for 3-4 years.
